








West African imports of plastics technology increase to €311 million in 2021

Ghana is a politically stable country and plastic packaging is becoming a necessity because of the fast growing small and medium enterprises. We access the market through our various distribution assets.


We had visitors, farmes and individuals in the herbal and chemical sector and other industries from the private and public sectors and others respectfully. We are satisfied with their quality.




